

Allow Pop-Ups in Microsoft Edge

Sometimes it is necessary to allow pop-ups so that a particular web application or website experience will work as expected. In those cases, you may need to include a particular URL in your pop-up Allow list.

1. In Edge, go to **Settings and more** at the top of your browser.
 2. Select **Settings > Privacy, search, and services** .
 3. Select **Site permissions > All permissions**.
 4. Select **Pop-ups and redirects** and go to **Allowed to send pop-ups and use redirects**.
 5. Select **Add site** and type in the URL that you want to allow to create pop-ups into the dialog box (starting with the **https://** portion at the beginning) and select **Add**. The URL should now appear in your Allow list.

Allowing Pop-Ups in Google Chrome (Computer)

By default, Chrome blocks pop-ups, but you can change the settings to allow them for all sites or specific ones.

Allow All Pop-Ups

1. Open **Google Chrome** on your computer.
 2. Click the **three dots** in the top-right corner and select **Settings**.
 3. In the left menu, click **Privacy and security**.
 4. Select **Site Settings**.
 5. Scroll down and click **Pop-ups and redirects**.
 6. Under **Default behavior**, select **Sites can send pop-ups and use redirects**.

Allow Pop-Ups from a Specific Site

1. Open **Google Chrome**.
2. Click the **three dots** in the top-right corner and select **Settings**.
3. Go to **Privacy and security > Site Settings**.

4. Scroll to **Pop-ups and redirects**.
 5. Under **Allowed to send pop-ups and use redirects**, click **Add**.
 6. Enter the site's web address and click **Add**. Tip: Use `[/*.]example.com` to allow all subdomains/].

Allowing Pop-Ups in Safari on Mac

You can allow pop-ups in Safari for specific websites or for all websites. This is useful when certain sites require pop-ups for features like statements, confirmations, or tools.

Allow Pop-Ups on One Website

1. Open the **Safari** app on your Mac.
 2. Go to the website where you want to allow pop-ups.
 3. Click **Safari** in the menu bar and select **Settings**.
 4. Click the **Websites** tab.
 5. Scroll down and select **Pop-up Windows** on the left.
 6. In the pop-up menu for the website, choose **Allow**.
